**What Time Is It?** – Now it is high time to awake out of sleep; for now, our salvation is nearer Romans 13:11

There are many ways of keeping time. Let us look at three of them.

1) The first is called “world time.” For many years this was how the world set its clocks. World time was determined by the relationship of the earth to the sun, and it enabled man to measure time by the movements of the heavens.

2) A second way of keeping time was adopted in 1972 when the switch was made to “atomic time.” This method measures hours, minutes, and seconds not merely by the big picture of the heavens but by the highly accurate vibrations of the atom.

3) Then there is a third method. It’s based on our “relationship to God”, and His time keeping is perfect. When we recognize our accountability to God, we see that now is the time to surround ourselves with the values, thoughts, and attitudes of the Lord Jesus Christ.
