<u>EYE SCREENING:</u> Wednesday, Oct. 22, 2025 -- The Washington-Greene County Blind Association will be visiting to tell the children the importance of eye safety. After the presentation, a visual screening will be offered to the children. This screening involves no medication and nothing will be placed into any child's eyes. A Parental Consent Form (attached) will need to be filled out and turned in if you want your child to participate in the screening.

L8:10

A young girl and her friend were arranging to attend an extended family gathering. Her friend was going to drive, but the girl wanted to use her own car. When she was asked why, she replied, "My car is my safe place. Somehow, I feel protected there." Her comment challenges us to consider our own personal "safe place." Certain physical places promise safety in moments that seem dangerous. A sturdy roof overhead in the midst of a storm, the comfort of a hospital offering medical care or the embrace of a loved one offer security and safety in times of need.

What is your "safe place"? Proverbs 18:10 tells us that God's name provides true protection for His people when they call upon Him. Wherever we seek safety, it is God's presence with us in that place that provides the strength and protection we really need.
