This will not be a regular school day. Please choose a time to bring your child in to complete the "spring" evaluation. At that time, you will be able to select an appointment to meet with your child's teacher for the PARENT-TEACHER Conferences in March.

TUITION PAYMENTS & LATE FEE: Our tuition policy states that if your tuition is not turned in by the 20th of the month prior to which payment is being collected, a \$20.00 late fee will need to be submitted with payment. Please review "Tuition Payment" policy in your Parent Handbook. Not turning in the late fee will cause your account to be delinquent. Your account will need to be kept current for your child to continue in the program. Thank you for your help and understanding in this matter.

ENROLLMENT & REFERRALS FOR SEPT. 2026-MAY 2027: Applications for registration next fall are being accepted. Why Love Gets Tough: Do not be like the horse or like the mule, which have no understanding which must be harnessed with bit and bridle. Psalm 32:9

While traveling through in the early 20th century Europe, James McConkey was a well-known Bible teacher went on a hike in the Swiss Alps.
