TUITION DUE: Tuition is due by the 1st of each month. When submitting your payment, please return the "gold" Tuition Statement so that we can record payment to the proper account. If paying by cash, you will need to wait until the end of the school session, and all the children have been released to reenter the facility to make payment. If payment is not received by the first of the month, at the end of your school day, please include a **\$15.00 late fee** making payment.

BOOK ORDERS: Reading books is a great way to promote developmental growth. When you place an order with Scholastic book clubs, our program will receive one point for every dollar spent. With those points we can order books to hand out to the children and educational items for the classroom.
